We serve an industry comprised of eight major segments, including aquatics, consumer, forestry, nursery and greenhouse, public health, structural pest control, turf and ornamental, and vegetation management. - Regulatory Affairs Committee promotes a consistent and transparent regulatory process at the federal and state levels
